PROCESS

There are two main methods used to make terrazzo: Poured-in-place and the precast.

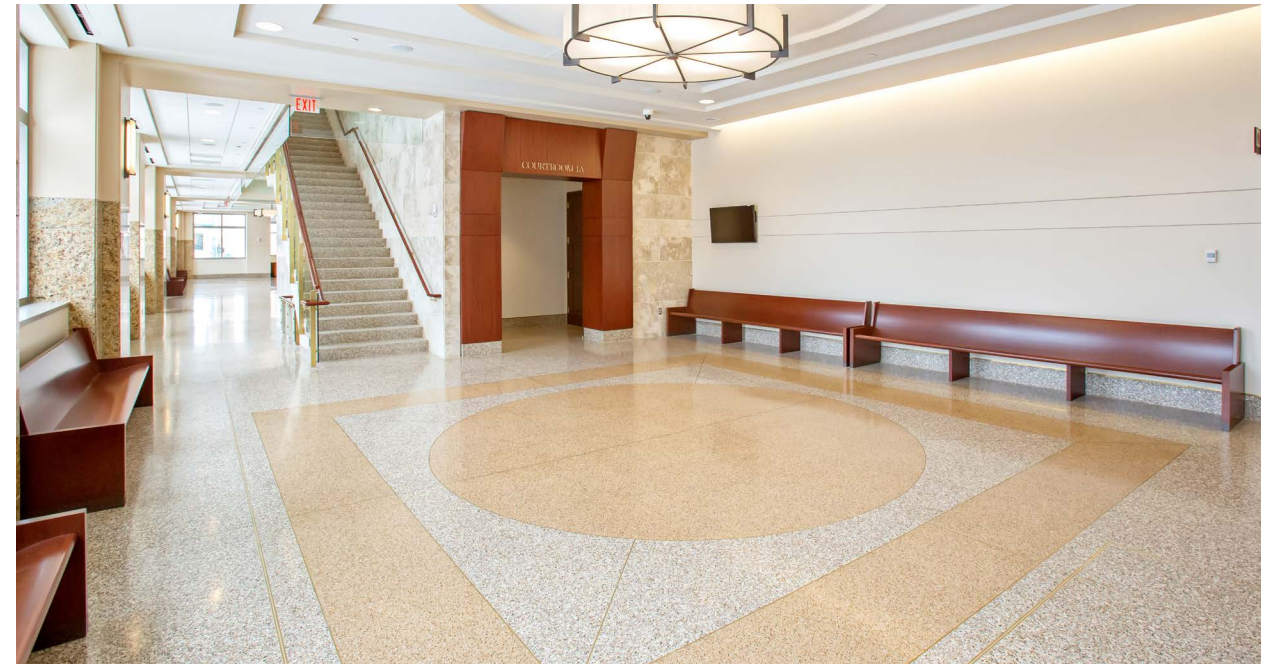
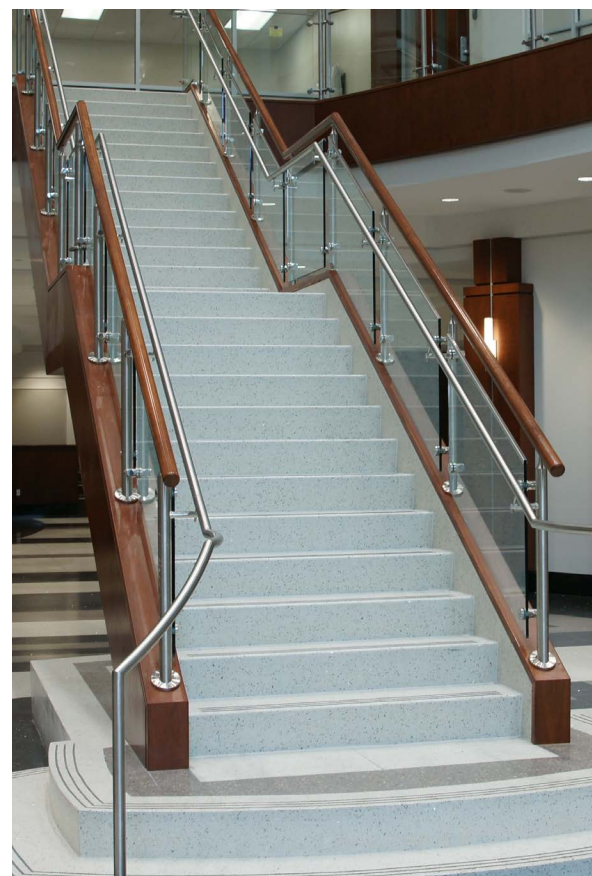
Poured-in-Place Method:

Concord Terrazzo Company provides the epoxy resins and aggregates for contractors to install a poured-in-place terrazzo system. The traditional method involves combining a 2-part epoxy resin system with choice of aggregates, and layered over a flooring substrate. The surface is then allowed to cure, and then is ground down to reveal a smooth, level surface. Finally, the surface is polished to a high shine and sealed for protection.

Precast Method:

The precast method of making terrazzo involves creating the products in a workshop, and then transporting it to the job site for installation. Concord Terrazzo's precast department hand crafts each precast unit by casting, cutting and polishing the terrazzo.

Both methods can produce high-quality terrazzo that stand the test of time, and the choice of which method to use will depend on a variety of factors, including the size of the project or design pattern. At Concord Terrazzo Company, TERRAZZCO Brand Products are used in the manufacturing of precast terrazzo and during the installation of a poured-in-place terrazzo floor.

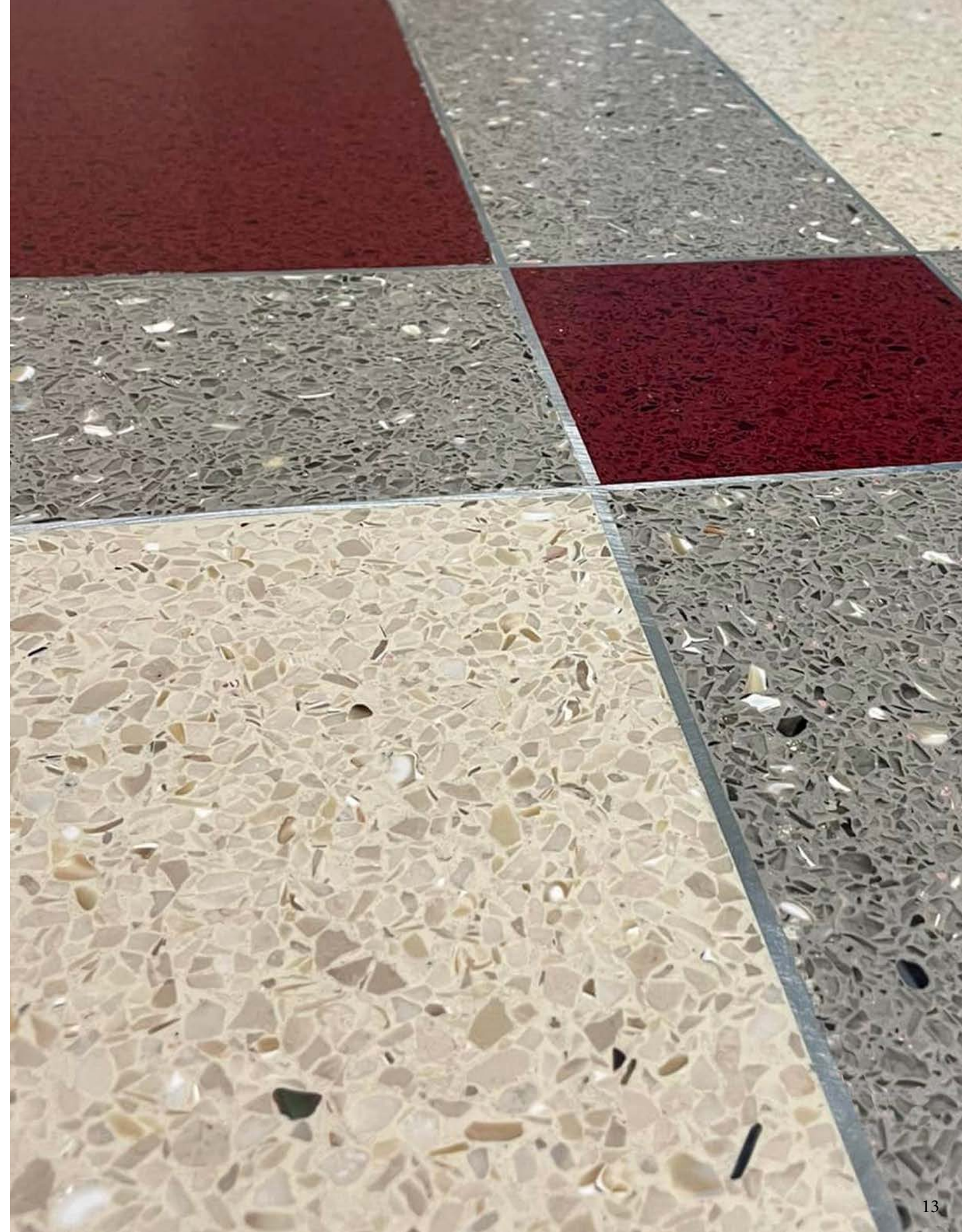

MMS 950 is a VOC free two-component epoxy resin cured with an animer curing agent and applied on the top surface of concrete slabs providing a barrier against moisture vapor transmission for slabs having a relative humidity of 90-99%

CHIP SIZES

Terrazzo aggregates come in three distinct sizes: micro, standard, and venetian.

Standard terrazzo chips are generally considered the most common and widely used in terrazzo applications. They are recommended for use in epoxy terrazzo installations. Standard sizes are available in size 0-2.

Micro and venetian aggregates can be considered as well. Micro aggregates result in a uniform surface with a finer grain appearance whereas venetian aggregates create a bold aesthetic with a visible aggregate pattern.

Concord Terrazzo Company crushes all TERRAZZCO Brand Aggregates into standard sizes for convenience.

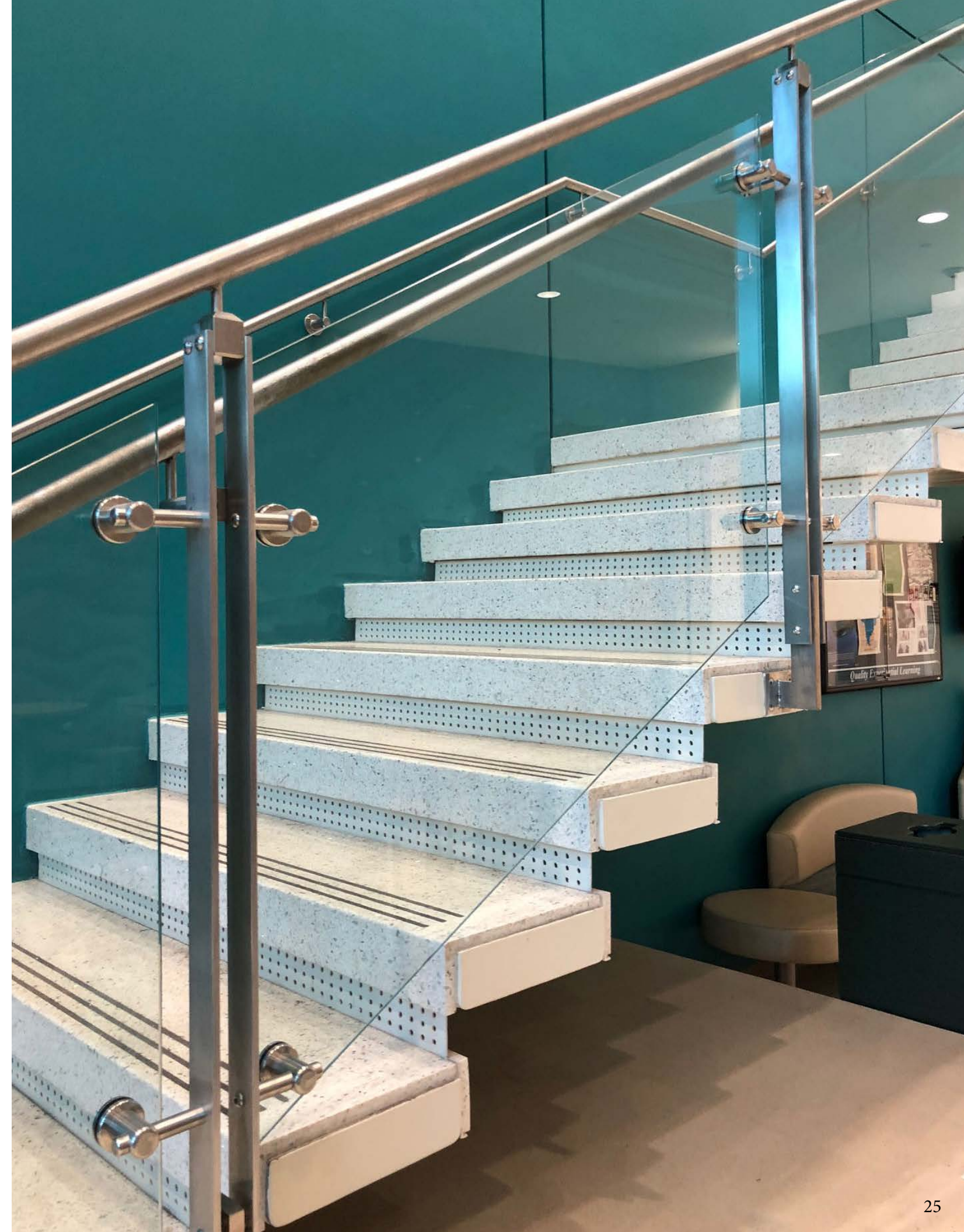

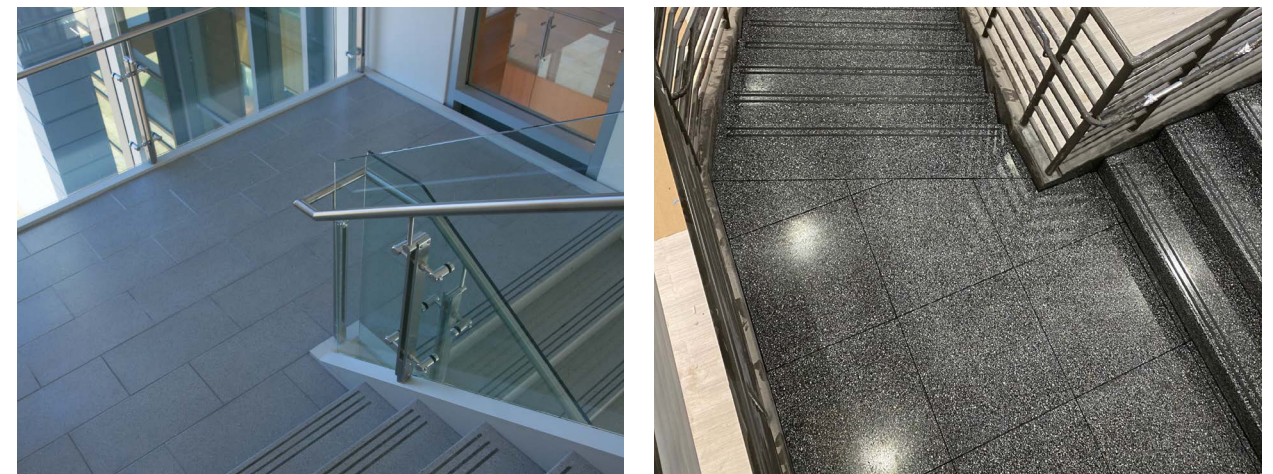

Nosing Options & Patterns
